NEUROLOGY

The neurology department at Dayanand Medical College and Hospital established in 1994 has rapidly grown from 10 bedded neurology unit to North India's leading tertiary care Neurology Department. Establishment of a dedicated Stroke Unit in the year 1996 marks as an important milestone in departmental growth. Year 2009 marks the beginning of DM Neurology program at DMCH.

Neurology Department is headed by Dr. Gagandeep Singh, who has done fellowship in Epilepsy at the National Hospital for Neurology and Neurosurgery, London. He is also the secretary of Indian Academy of Neurology since 2014. The other department faculty include - Dr Rajinder K. Bansal, Dr Birinder S. Paul & Dr Monika Singla.

DMCH possesses North India's first epilepsy pre-surgical workup unit with long term EEG telemetry. With close co-operation from Department of Radiology and Neurosurgery, DMCH is successfully running high-end MRI epilepsy protocols and advanced epilepsy surgery facility. State of art, fully equipped 30 bedded neurology ward has recently been inaugurated.

Neurology department offers state of art workup and treatment facilities for neuro-immunological disorders (multiple sclerosis, autoimmune encephalitis) and advanced neuro-genetics workup with various national and international institutes.

CIFE (Community Interventions for Epilepsy)

Neurology department runs an extensive research cum outreach program, known as CIFE (Community Interventions for Epilepsy) with support from the India Council of Medical Research. Under this program 65000 people around Ludhiana city have been screened and people with epilepsy are provided free medication and diagnostic workup.

The future projects of department include development of neuro-intervention services for stroke, deep brain stimulation for Parkinson's disease and expansion of the indications for epilepsy surgery.



KIDNEY TRANSPLANT UNIT

Senior Kidney Transplant Surgeon

Dr Ravi Angral recently joined DMCH as Senior Kidney Transplant Surgeon. Dr Angral has been trained at PGIMER, Chandigarh and has 16 years of experience in kidney transplantation. He has exclusively conducted renal transplant surgeries and has performed more than 1000 surgeries and has vast expertise in this field.

Chronic kidney disease (CKD) is a global health threat. Incidence of CKD has doubled in last 15 years. In India estimated incidence of end-stage renal disease (ESRD) is 152 per million population. Renal transplant unit is dedicated exclusively for kidney transplant patients and post transplant care.

A renovated transplant unit offers ultramodern monitoring facilities, positive pressure air circulation, and separate units for each patient. Kidney transplant unit offers.

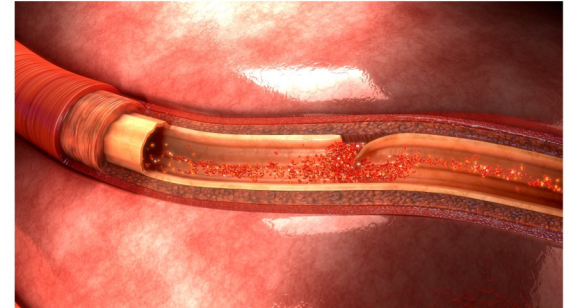
1. **Living related transplant-** For patients with near relative donor, pediatric transplant donor, minimal invasive donor surgery.
2. **Cadaveric kidney transplant-** Cadaveric / deceased donor is brain dead donor with beating heart on life support system. Centre is recognized for living as well deceased donor transplant and will run programme as per NOTTO protocol (National Organ and Tissue Transplant).
3. **ABO Incompatible transplant-** To overcome blood group barrier and shortage of organs, ABO incompatible transplant is done by plasmapheresis, double filtration plasmapheresis, Immunoabsorption technique.
4. **Swap transplant/ Paired Donor Exchange-** Swap transplant is legal as per HOTA (Human Organ Transplant Act) and helps to expand donor pool in living related transplant. In a paired exchange, a donor donates their kidney to another recipient in exchange for a compatible kidney for their loved one.

ENDOVASCULAR STENT GRAFTING

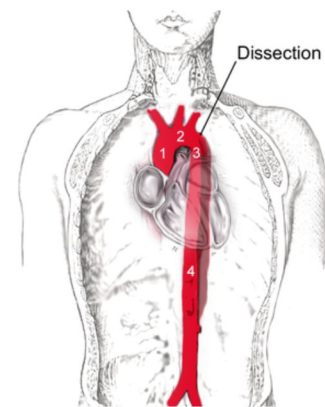
Endovascular Stent Grafting is a minimally invasive method to treat an aortic aneurysm. Instead of an open aneurysm repair in which chest and abdomen are surgically opened, heart team may consider a procedure called an endovascular aneurysm repair (EVAR). This procedure needs collaboration with Cardiovascular and Thoracic Surgery (CVTS) team. Very few centres are doing endovascular aneurysmal repair as this procedure needs high expertise.



Q1: Where can Endovascular Stent Grafting be used?

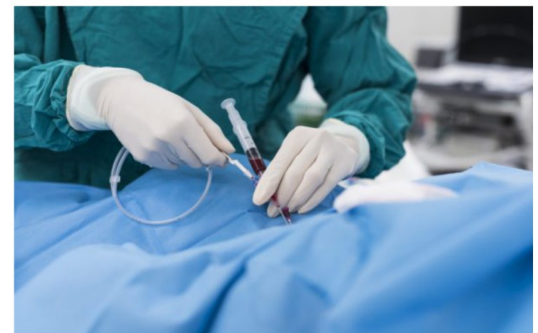
Ans: Endovascular stent grafting is indicated in following clinical scenarios:

- Aortic dissection (acute and chronic)
- Aortic aneurysm (descending thoracic aortic aneurysms)
- Aortic rupture secondary to massive blunt traumatic injury
- Post traumatic pseudoaneurysm
- Post traumatic active bleeding vessels



Q2: What is important during Endovascular Stent Grafting?

Ans: During endovascular stent grafting, we need to maintain appropriate positioning of the stent graft and take care of side branches supplying the major organs (eg. carotid vessels, renal arteries)



Q3: How long does the procedure take?

Ans: The average time for the procedure is 30-45 minutes.

Q4: Are there complications of Endovascular Stent Grafting?

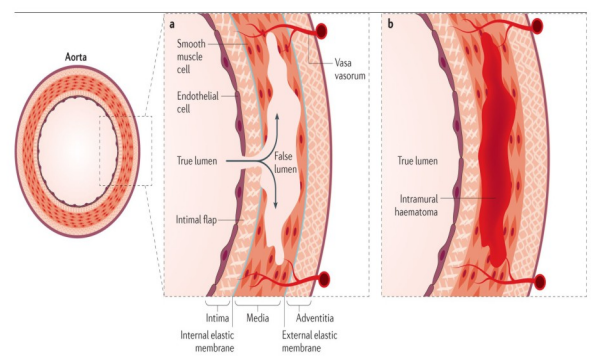
Ans: Complications following EVAR can occur early or late. Renal impairment, graft-related endoleak, device occlusion, migration, distal embolisation and femoral access site complications etc. may be encountered.

Q5: What are the reasons for doing Endovascular Stent Grafting?

Ans: Endovascular stent grafting had came up as a percutaneous modality that carries a lower morbidity and mortality compared to the open surgical repairs.

Q6: Are there alternatives to Endovascular Stent Grafting?

Ans: Endovascular stent grafting is a minimally invasive procedure. Open surgical procedure is the preferred treatment for ascending aorta aneurysms. This can be used as a sole alternative or as a part of hybrid procedure in complex thoracic aorta aneurysm.

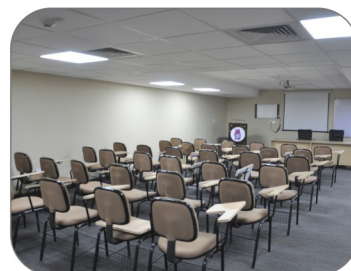

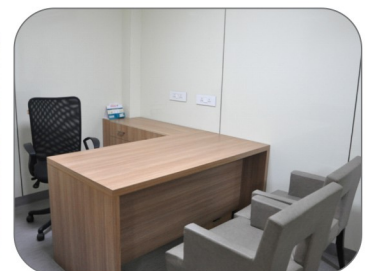

Newly Acquired Equipments

CT Scan in Emergency

The institution has one of the busiest emergency in the country with an intake of 100 patients per day including trauma patients. To provide prompt diagnostic services to the patients, DMCH has installed 64 slice CT SCAN machine of siemens made in Germany in emergency area.



Extracorporeal Membrane Oxygenation (ECMO)

DMCH has taken lead in ECMO therapy, which is available in selected medical centres in the world. This therapy helps in survival of aluminium phosphide intoxicated patients, the fatal toxin known as 'celphos'. ECMO has saved lives of patients with swine flu and other respiratory failures.



Brachytherapy Facility

"Brachytherapy" – a modern radiation therapy was launched at DMCH Cancer Care Centre. It is internal radiation which is highly effective in treating many types of cancer (prostate, skin, breast, cervix, etc.) and gives a higher level of accuracy in comparison to conventional surgery.



Fully Automated Multistainer

This equipment is aquired by the pathology department, and helps in automatic tissue detection, focus calibration, compression, viewing images and includes applications that facilitate image management, sharing, and image analysis.



MiraQ Cardiac

Department of Cardiac Surgery has MiraQ to improve surgical outcomes and increase efficiency. It combines the spatial information from epicardial ultrasound imaging and quantitative data which enables the surgeon to perform prompt and accurate assessment. This may lead to modifications of the surgical strategy and thus contribute towards reduced rates of major adverse cardiac and cerebrovascular events (MACCE) following surgery.

Paramedical Courses

As part of the State Government's initiative to prepare skilled workforce in the health care sector and to create better employment opportunities for the youth of Punjab, DMCH, Ludhiana has started 13 Paramedical degree (BSc) as well as 10 Diploma courses in various specialities with total intake of 235 seats i.e. 135 degree and 100 diploma seats per year.

Prof. Livtar S. Chawla is a name that evokes a sense of reverence in the minds of medical students blessed by his tutelage. It's our honor to remember an eminent teacher and an astute physician, who not only shaped many careers but also inspired many physicians all over the world.

On August 31st, 2018 we lost a visionary soul whose farsightedness blazed a progressive path for DMC & H. Prof. Livtar S. Chawla was born on Sept 27, 1934 in Gujranwala. His medical journey started with graduation from Amritsar Medical College where he went on to do his post-graduation in Internal Medicine. Following his post-graduation, he joined Dept of Medicine at PGIMER, Chandigarh, and earned academic laurels with numerous national and international publications.

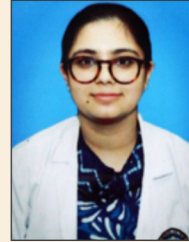
